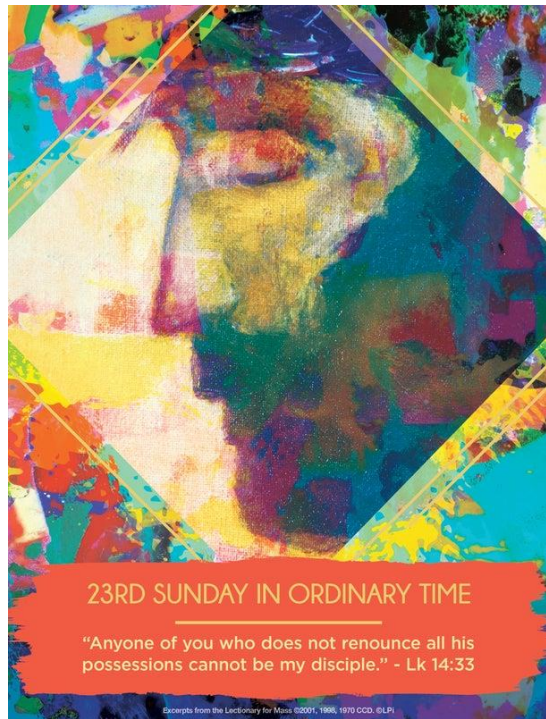

Diocesan Appeal

Our 2025-2026 Diocesan Appeal has begun. The timing of this appeal allows us to ask our summer families to help with this huge undertaking. This appeal pays for schooling and training for our clergy, deacons, seminarian formation, hospitals,

college chaplains, and many other operational support systems necessary to successfully perform all the tasks required by the Diocese. Opening this appeal early gives you the opportunity to spread the payments over a longer period of time. The assessment for St. Isaac Jogues is \$15,429. This is \$88 more than last year. The assessment for Blessed Sacrament is \$18,895. This represents a \$2,147 decrease from last year.

The calculation of the appeal in each parish is based on the parish's offertory for an average of 3 years.
